STABLING: 10x10 vinyl with doors in a permanent barn, or box stalls of wooden construction in a permanent barn.

Stabling will be available at \$125.00 for the weekend, bedding included.

RULES & REGULATIONS

HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY EVERYONE WHEN MOUNTED.

- In some classes, the area of the courtesy circle is restricted. This will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes should lack of entries warrant and to refuse any entry.
- All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes any under saddle class.
- A rotating jumping order will be established and posted for all classes over fences.
- No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

Schooling may be available each evening after course adjustment.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Hunter class. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an Under Saddle class.

VERY GREEN HUNTER – Classes 2, 3, 4

Open to horses and ponies. Horses and ponies may not cross enter into any class with fences higher than 2'6", and may only receive points in this section for one year. Fences 2'6".

LOW HUNTER - Classes 5, 6, 10

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 2'9" - 3'.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER 3' or 3'3" – Classes 7, 8, 9

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' - 3'3" fences. Fences not to exceed 3'3".

GREEN/HIGH PERFORMANCE HUNTER 3'6", 3'9" and 4' - Classes 12, 13, 14

A Green Hunter is a horse of any age that is in his first or second year of showing in any classes. Fences to be 3'6" for 1st year horses, 3'9" for 2nd year horses and 4' for high performance horses. To be judged on performance and soundness.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER – Classes 40, 41, 42

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other OPHA recognized section. No oxer and no In and Out. Fences 2'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY – Classes 45, 46, 47

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show. Fences 2' for small, 2'3" for medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed height of fence.

NON-PROFESSIONAL HUNTER – Classes 49, 50, 51

Open to Amateur and Junior riders with limited experience. Judged on performance and soundness. Fences 2'6".

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER – Classes 52, 53, 54

To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any class in which fences are 2"6" or higher. Fences 2'6". Entries need not be jogged for soundness.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER 3' – Classes 56, 57, 59

To be ridded by a Junior exhibitor. Neither horses or riders may cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Spreads not to exceed fence heights. Entries need not be jogged for soundness.

PONY HUNTER – Classes 63, 64, 65

Classes limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under, and show by riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of pony and rider emphasized. Extreme speed penalized. Measurement cards required. Small ponies 2'3", Medium ponies 2'6", Large ponies 3'.

GREEN PONY HUNTER – Classes 112, 113, 114

A green pony is a pony of any age not exceeding 14.2 hands that has not been shown over fences at the regulation height or higher for its respective section. Fences: Small ponies 2'3", Medium ponies 2'6", Large ponies 2'9".

JUNIOR HUNTER 3'6" - Classes 69, 70, 71

Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Measurement cards required. Performance, soundness and manners to count. Extreme speed penalized.

AMATEUR OWNER 3'3" or 3'6" - Classes 73, 74, 75

To be ridden by Amateur Owners or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

LOW ADULT HUNTER - Classes 77, 78, 79

Open to Amateur Riders with limited experience. Cross entry between the Low Adult section and the Amateur Owner section is prohibited. Fences 2'6".

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER 2'9" TO 3' - Classes 80, 81, 82

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter Division may compete one horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division. Fences 2'9" - 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Entries need not to be jogged for soundness.

SCHOOLING SHOW CLASSES

WALK / TROT - Classes 96, 97, 98, 99

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

WALK / TROT / CANTER - Classes 101, 102, 103, 104

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

LIMIT RIDER - Classes 86, 87, 88, 89

Open to riders of any age. Fences 2'. Oxers not permitted.

NOVICE RIDER - Classes 91, 92, 93, 94

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Fences 2'3" to 2'6".

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Jumper class. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded in the Low Children's/ Adult Jumper, Children's /Adult Jumper and Junior/Amateur Divisions.

LOW CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER - Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a Junior or Amateur exhibitor. Riders cannot cross enter into any class at the same show with fences 3'3" or higher. Fences 3' – **Classes 105, 106, 107**

CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER - Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a Junior competitor, and exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. All adults must be Amateurs. The horse/rider combination may not compete in any other class at the same show where fences exceed 3'9". Fences 3'6" - Min. speed 360 yds/min. Classes – 27, 28, 29

TRAINING JUMPER - Fences 3' - Min. Speed 360 yds/min. - Classes 22, 23, 24

OPEN JUMPER - Fences 3'9" - 4' Min. speed 360 yds/min. Classes - 33, 34

SCHOOLING JUMPER - Class – 25 Fences 3'6" Min. speed 360 yds/min. Class – 26 Fences 3'6" Min. speed 360 yds/min

JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPER - Horses in this section must be ridden by an Amateur Owner or Amateur member of the owner's family or by a Junior exhibitor. Fences 3'9" 4' -Min. speed 360 yds/min. **Classes – 30, 31**

OPEN JUMPER - Open to all horses. Fences 4' - Min. speed 360 yds/min. Classes – 33, 34 HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION

All classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Eight ribbons will be awarded in each class.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 each, except where otherwise noted.

CLASS:

FLAT EQUITATION 17 AND UNDER - Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Test 1-19 optional. – **Class 72**

ADULT EQUITATION/FLAT - Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. – Class 83

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION/FLAT - Short Stirrup riders 11 yrs. & under - Class 43

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY EQUITATION/FLAT - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring – Class 117

LOW CHILDREN'S EQUITATION/FLAT - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. – Class 55

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION/FLAT - Riders eligible for the Children's divisions. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. – **Class 60**

PONY EQUITATION/FLAT

To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Test 1-7 optional. - Class 66

FOX SMITH MEDAL - Open to riders eligible for the Children's Hunter Division. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 3', with two changes of direction. - Class 58 ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications.

OPHA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL CLASSENTRY FEE: \$25.00 Open to Junior riders. Fences 3'6". – Class 68

NARHA MEDAL.....ENTRY FEE: \$25.00

Adult Equitation Class. Open to all Amateur riders except Amateur owners. Fences 3'. – Class 84

DICK GASCOIGNE PONY MEDAL......ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 See USEF Rule Book for Specifications. – Class 61

HUNTER BREEDING

Open to thoroughbred and non-thoroughbred horses. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a Hunter. Horses are to be walked and/or jogged before being moved on the line in order of preference. – **Classes 35, 36, 37, 38**

PONY HUNTER BREEDING

Open to ponies not to exceed 14.2 hands. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a pony hunter. Ponies are to be walked and/or jogged before being moved on the line in order of preference. – **Classes 108, 109, 110, 111**




