- 1.) Applicants must be a current active member of the OPHA for a minimum of at least one show season (must have joined by March 1st, 2024)
- 2.) Applicants must complete 12 community service hours within the past year and provide documentation including name and phone number of the person supervising the time donated.
- 3.) Applicants are required to submit documentation of a GPA of 3.5 or higher from their school that they currently attend.
- 4.) Applicants must complete an essay (500 word minimum) on one of the three topics provided on the application form.
- 5.) Applicants must provide a 3X5 inch photo that does not need to be returned.
- 6.) Applicants must complete and return application and essay no later than October 26th, 2024. Any application received after this date will not be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!

The OPHA will not accept any application that is not completed in its entirety. No exceptions.

A Certificate of Scholarship will be awarded to the winning applicants at the November 2024 awards presentation.

The Scholarship funds will be mailed to the school for the recipient's choice upon notice of acceptance and enrollment.
